


Starting with VA 5.1 SP1, what SACID do I enter for wildcard licenses?

This article pertains to the application of wildcard license files for Validation Authority. A wildcard license is one in which the license is valid for any IP address. Temporary license files are included in this. Starting with VA 5.1 SP1, to apply a wild card license, you will be prompted to enter a SAC. In the case of temporary license files, the file name will look something like "VA Responder Temp [SAC 76689].txt". That is to say, the SAC value (a 5-digit number) is embedded in the file name itself. This is the SAC you enter for the box "Enter SAC ID:" (see image below). This only applies for temporary licenses. If you have a permanent wildcard license it will have your organizations SAC embedded in its name. In this case you must enter your organizations SAC ID number.
